

BEHAVIORAL AGREEMENT FOR STUDENTS

I understand that I must abide by the following behavioral guidelines while participating in Solid Foundation courses and activities:

- 1 I will speak and act respectfully toward all adults, both teachers and parents.
- 2 I will speak and act kindly toward the other students, including those younger than myself. I will not ridicule or make fun of anyone for any reason.
- 3 If I say the name of God (or Jesus) it will be in a respectful manner, not in an off-handed way or in anger. I will also not use crass vocabulary (i.e. "four-letter words").
- 4 I will not solve disputes with other students using physical violence.
- 5 I will not willfully damage any part, interior or exterior, of any building SFEA meets in.
- 6 I will dress modestly (girls, this means no cleavage or bellies showing). Please see the back of this sheet for clarification.)
- 7 I understand that SFEA classes may require some work during the week. I will do the best I can to complete out-of-class assignments.

I have read and understand the above statements.

I understand that to be involved in Solid Foundation activities is a privilege, not a right, and if I consistently violate the above contract I will not be allowed to participate in SFEA activities.

SFEA's dress code is the same as that of the public school system. We do not require any more than what our entire community (as represented by the SCASD school board) feels is reasonable.

The State High dress code is as follows:

The dress code serves not as a means for staff to tell students how to dress but as a standard for proper attire in a public educational facility. The school also has a general expectation regarding the way students present themselves; mainly that all appear in clean and appropriate clothing that follows the guidelines listed below:

- *Dress must not interfere with the educational process or the rights of others.*
- *Dress must comply with all health and safety codes. Shoes must be worn at all times. Sunglasses may not be worn in the building.*
- *All headwear is prohibited with the exception of religious headwear.*
- *Any clothing or jewelry with printed material that may be considered obscene, offensive or inappropriate is prohibited.*
- *Sharp, studded apparel and jewelry are not permitted in light of the potential danger to others and property.*
- *Since we are a drug, alcohol, and tobacco free school district, we do not permit the wearing of items that advertise or promote the use of drugs, alcohol or tobacco products.*
- *Any clothing that inappropriately exposes one's body is prohibited:*
- *Shirts: the top of the shirt must reach no lower than a few inches below the collarbone (so that absolutely no cleavage is showing), straps must be a minimum of 1" wide, no undergarments showing, no muscle shirts, and when standing and with arms down, a student's upper garment should at least meet the lower garment.*
- *Skirts/dresses: hem length must be no higher than mid thigh, no leggings without shorts or skirt*
- *Shorts: length no higher than mid-thigh (or half way down/up the thigh), no short shorts, no holes exposing skin*
- *Pants: Capri, ankle, or full length worn without showing any undergarments, free from holes above the knee*

State High allows one warning, accompanied by changing into compliant clothing. Second and third violations are given detentions, and further violations are then handled as disciplinary offenses and turned over to staff who specialize in disciplinary issues (the guidelines for which are printed in their handbook).
